Task 1: Develop a sustainable environmental management plan for an agribusiness

Set sustainable environmental management goals and objectives which meet regulatory requirements, meet regional compliance standards, and are consistent with industry best practice.

Source information and data to develop a sustainable environmental management plan.

Analyse current environmental management practices, and identify any shortcomings in current practice.

Construct a sustainable environmental management plan for the agribusiness.

By providing:

A report on current environmental practices and identify any shortcomings in current practice. If you identify any current environmental management practice that is not appropriate, state how the practice should be changed (approx. 150 words).

A list of the information required to create a sustainable environmental management plan.

Provide your own, or develop a sustainable environmental management plan for your agribusiness workplace. This needs to include your key sustainable environmental management goals and objectives. Provide references that show they meet regulatory and compliance requirements of the Authority in your area, and the requirements of the RMA. Describe how each goal and objective meets industry best practice. Note: for a pastoral based agribusiness, you must include a nutrient budget. It could be written by you or someone else, but you must include an explanation that demonstrates that you can interpret the nutrient budget and the key drivers for using it in nutrient management.

Develop key contingencies into a contingency plan and address how the contingencies will manage possible variations to the main plan.

Implement your plan, and record the progress, against an appropriate milestone, (time based or results based) including any variations that occurred during the implementation, and any parts of your plan that needed to be reviewed and amended.

Attestation from your Line Manager (or equivalent) that you have developed a sustainable environmental management plan for an agribusiness, and

implemented it and reviewed progress in accordance with workplace requirements.
