Assessment

You are required to submit evidence of the following:

1. Undertake a work-based project or inquiry to advance knowledge and skills in learning design, in accordance with an agreed proposal.
2. Evidence a critical commentary on how work-based learning has advanced own knowledge and skills in learning design.

To earn this EduBit, all work must be your own and you must submit evidence exactly as requested in the Task instructions.

When you've finished gathering your evidence, press Purchase. Trained and experienced assessors are standing by to evaluate your evidence and provide feedback on how you did for each task, as well as how you did overall.

- If your evidence does not yet meet the requirements, we will provide feedback on what is missing and encourage you to practice your skills and attempt the EduBit again at a later date.
- If there are minor gaps in your submission evidence, you will be given the opportunity to resubmit. You will have 14 calendar days to add the missing evidence and submit for re-evaluation.

Tasks

Task 1: Demonstrate that you can develop a project proposal for a purposeful work-based learning project to advance knowledge and skills in learning design.

You will need to:

1.1. Submit a project proposal for a purposeful work-based learning project that will clearly advance your knowledge and skills in learning design.

The project proposal must outline relevant information including:

- The project aim.
- Brief background and context.
- Project goal/s.
- Statement of why this project is important in your context.
- A proposed action plan or methodology (as appropriate).
- Ethical considerations.

If your project requires ethics approval, you will also need to upload the approval document.

Suggested max. word count: 1000 words.

Task 2: Evidence implementation of your work-based learning project and evidence a critical commentary on your experiences.

You will need to:

2.1. Provide a range of evidence that you have implemented your project in accordance with the project proposal.

Examples of evidence include:

- Annotated bibliography.
- Minutes of professional conversations or meetings.
- Project products e.g. assessments or planning documentation.
- Feedback/Evaluations.
- Data gathered and subsequent analysis.

2.2. Provide a critical commentary that spans the length of the project from start to finish and that:

- Describes a range of experiences.
- Critically examines those experiences e.g.
 - Examines assumptions, strength and weaknesses in learning design.
 - Examines impact/s on self or others.
 - Examines need for change (what and how).
- Articulates what you have learned about learning design, how you learned it and how it will inform future practice.
